YOUTH STAFF PACKING GUIDE

Below is an overview of items we recommend to bring with you onboard. Considering the size of your onboard cabin, remember not to pack too much; bring clothes, shoes and accessories that you can mix and match

DAYTIME and EVENINGS ON DUTY:

- Males/Females: You will be given a UNIFORM when you arrive. It's a sporty look, shorts and a Carnival logo shirt. *Please bring (a lot of) white socks and a pair of athletic shoes.*
 - o Camp Ocean/Animators/Circle C: Bright Blue Shoes
 - o Club O2: Red Shoes

DAYTIME OFF DUTY:

- In Guest Areas:
 - o Female: Sleeved shirt, minimum mid-thigh length skirts or shorts, sleeved dresses, closed-toe shoes. No denim is permitted in guest areas.
 - Male: Collared shirt, non-cargo shorts or pants, closed-toe shoes. No denim is permitted in guest areas.
- When you are out in port or not in guest areas, you may wear whatever you wish.

EVENINGS OFF DUTY (Camp Staff work most evenings):

• Elegant/Formal nights - "Cruise Elegant"

Depending on the length of the voyage, ships have either one or two formal (Cruise Elegant) nights, and depending on your schedule you may have elegant evenings free.

When off duty, Camp Carnival Staff will be expected to dress formally if you wish to spend your time out in Guest Areas.

- o Female: Cocktail dresses with closed-toe shoes (peep-toe ok)**
- Male: Suit/Jacket with tie & matching shoes **
- Non- Elegant/Formal nights "Cruise Casual"

Depending on your schedule, you may have non-elegant evenings free.

When off duty, Camp Carnival Staff will be expected to dress appropriately if you wish to spend your time out in Guest Areas.

- Female: Dress or suit skirt/pants & blouse with closed-toe shoes. **
- Male: Dress pants with belt and matching shoes, long sleeved collared shirt tucked in. **
- **SHOES: Both *Males and Females* have a pair of **Black dress shoes for Elegant Evenings** (females: heels or flats). Any color *closed-toed shoes* maybe worn on non-elegant evenings.

<u>JUST FOR THE FUN OF IT</u>: Pack some fun accessories! Remember to consider the time frame of your contract (Halloween, St. Paddy's, etc.) and pack accordingly, if you wish to participate.

Helpful items:

- O Wrist Watch
- O Battery Operated Alarm Clock
- O Toiletries for approximately two weeks, you will have time to shop for more when you get settled. (esp. deodorant & breath mints, your guests will thank you;)
- O At least \$200 in cash as "just in case" money. Be aware that it may be two to three weeks before you receive your first paycheck. Plan accordingly and bring any additional funds if you feel you may require it.
- O Warm Clothing the ship has constant air-conditioning

Optional items:

- O Sunglasses, beach towel, bathing suits, sunscreen, etc.
- O Hair dryers
- O laptop/tablet ***Don't forget your Universal converter/adapter!
- O Photos of family & friends for your cabin.
